FACTS

WHAT DOES ADVISER SOCIUS FAMILY OFFICE, LLC (“SOCIUS”) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

WHY?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
WHAT?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Social security number ▪ Income ▪ Assets ▪ Risk tolerance ▪ Transaction history ▪ Employment details
HOW?	All financial companies need to share customers’ personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers’ personal information; the reasons SOCIUS chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do

How does SOCIUS protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does SOCIUS collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you:

- Enter into an investment advisory contract
- Seek financial advice
- Make deposits or withdrawals from your account
- Tell us about your investment or retirement portfolio
- Give us your employment history

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only:

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for non-affiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *SOCIUS is affiliated with, Alterna Financial, LLC, Alterna Capital Management, LLC, and Alterna Tax Asset Group.*

Non-affiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.

- *Non-affiliates we can share with include Broker-Dealers, Investment Managers, Custodians and Fund Administrators.*

Joint Marketing

A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- *SOCIUS does not jointly market.*
